Project Summary

This project involved the redesign of curbs, gutters and sidewalks to include larger curb pop-outs, for more queuing area for pedestrians. Included into the design were new traffic lights for diagonal pedestrian crossing. This feature, known as a pedestrian scramble, not only enhances pedestrian traffic flow by enabling more people to cross at one time, but also allows for more uninterrupted vehicular traffic flow.

Nasland Engineering's responsibilities included preparation of a base map, conceptual plans, traffic studies, construction documents, cost estimates, specifications, bid documents and consultation during construction.
