Project Summary

Due to rapid campus growth and other factors, the University of California, San Diego (UCSD) has undertaken the development of a combined home for the catering activities and the Housing & Dining Services (HDS) division’s administrative offices. The project site is directly west of the existing Reville Commons/Plaza Café building and east of Scholars Drive South. It is served by outside deliveries via its proximity to North Torrey Pines Road, Scholars Drive South and the existing Reville Commons service yard. The Natural Sciences Building, directly to the north, also shares the service yard. This four-story building has a Catering Kitchen on level one, Catering Sales and Conference Services on level two, and staff offices on levels three and four.

Nasland Engineering’s responsibilities included preparation of a base utility map, preparation of plans and specifications for construction, and coordinating with the UCSD as well as other members of the design team. Nasland Engineering provided grading, utility, and drainage plans for this project while achieving the highest LEED credits possible. The plans were prepared to regional standards and processed with UCSD for plan check and any necessary permits.
